GENERAL TRIP POLICIES

There are some basic policies that all trip participants should understand prior to registering for this trip. Please read each of the general policy items listed below:

- Registration opens on February 1, 2015
- Every participant must be registered as a Girl Scout Junior (by the time of the trip), Cadette, Senior, Ambassador or Adult.
- No tagalongs (unregistered siblings/friends) all trip participants must meet the age and registration requirements.
- Rooming arrangements may require participants to share rooms with members from another troop or group. This applies to girls and adults.
- Understand that everyone will get to tour the Birthplace but programs are for <u>girls only</u> with appropriate adult/girl ratios.
- Birthplace t-shirts will be pre-ordered before the trip. This will be an additional cost. Information and cost
 details will be provided to trip participants once they are finalized.
- Every participant (girls and adults) is required to have a health physical between May 2015 and November 2015. A copy of the physical must be provided with your final payment on 12/1/2015.

EXPECTATIONS

In addition to the information on the Extended Trip Participant Agreement and Code of Conduct, trip participants will be expected to agree to the following:

- Stay with the group at all times
- Treat all trip participants (adults AND girls) with respect
- Wear appropriate clothing and footwear (including uniform when required) while on the trip
- Follow all directions provided by Trip Leader (or other adults)
- Never go ANYWHERE alone. Always stay with at least one buddy.
- Be responsible for yourself and your belongings
- Help keep the trip safe and FUN for everyone

Trip adults are also expected to agree to the following:

- Provide email address for communication
- Be included in the required Adult/Girl ratio
- Act as an adult chaperone for all girls on the trip (not just your own daughter(s)/troop members, etc)
- Provide adult leadership & guidance to the girls
- Participate in all activities
- Tobacco and Alcohol use is Prohibited

UNDERSTANDING THE COSTS

It is important that all participants understand how the trip will be financed and how the money/payments will be processed.

- A deposit is required to reserve each space. The deposit is applied to the total per-person cost.
- The deposit is REFUNDABLE until 9/30/2015 only if the space can be filled by another traveler.
- You are responsible for the payment of the per-person cost for each space you reserve.
- The estimated trip cost is \$675 per person.
- The final trip cost will not be determined until November 1, 2015.
- The per-person trip cost could go up (or down) based on trip specifics including (but not limited to) spaces filled and fee changes.
- Payment in full is required no later than DECEMBER 1, 2015. You can choose to pay all at once or choose the bi-monthly payment plan.
- The per-person cost DOES NOT include spending money, patches, or lunch on the way to or home from Savannah. All other expenses (transportation, lodging, meals, and activities) are included.
- Birthplace pin and patch cost is included. Patches for other activities and locations may be available for purchase on your own.

CANCELLING YOUR TRIP

If for some reason you/your daughter cannot attend the trip after you have already made payments, special circumstances will apply.

- All cancellation requests must be received in WRITING.
- For cancellations after registration:
 - Your space will be offered to the first available adult/girl (depending on the adult/girl ratio needed) on the waiting list.
 - Once your space is filled, you will receive a full refund of any payments that have been made.
 Every effort will be made to find a replacement traveler.
